### Hadley Elementary School

Hadley Elementary School has 277 students in kindergarten through grade 6

- 33 students attend the Hadley preschool program
- In 2014 Hadley Elementary implemented *Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports*. School-wide Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports is a systems approach to establishing the social culture and behavioral supports needed for all children in a school to achieve both social and academic success. Last year, disciplinary incidents on HES school buses decreased by 96% between October 2015 to April 2016
- In 2015, HES implemented a tiered instructional model designed to provide students with literacy instruction specifically matched to their learning needs. Data from year 1 indicate students in grades 1-3 exceeded learning goals on mid-year literacy as-

### Hopkins Academy

- 273 students grades 7-12 with an average grade enrollment of 46 students
- Strong athletic program – received Sportsmanship Award for District F.
- Percentage of students enrolled in post secondary institutions after Graduation from HA exceeds state average
- 100% of students at HA complete the Mass Core Curriculum – curriculum designed to ensure students are prepared for college
- Percentage of students completing Advanced Placement courses exceeds state average

### District

- Hadley Public Schools was cited in the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's publication *On Track with Educator Evaluation; Promising Practices in Massachusetts' Public Schools* (May 2015)
- 100% of HPS educators are highly qualified
- Hadley has many strong and involved parent groups including the Hadley Special Education Parents' Advisory Council, the PTO, and the Hadley Mothers' Club among others.
- Student Growth Percentiles for English Language Learners in the district range from moderate to very high, with the majority of English Language Learners demonstrating very high growth in 2015.
- In 2016, the majority of district educators (including educator support professionals) became certified in Mental Health First Aid training – a national, 8 hour certification course.
- In FY16, the Hadley Public Schools budget document received the Meritorious Budget Award (Pathways Program) from the Association of School Business Officials.
