Call to Order/Members Present

Fasihuddin called the meeting order at 9:00 AM. The following members were present: Grant and Fasihuddin.

Record of Votes

- Policy JICH Use of Controlled Substances— Grant recommends amending policy JICH to reflect the policy recommended by MASC with one revision, elimination of the words "by students" in the second sentence of paragraph one. Fasihuddin seconds. Vote 2-0-0.
- Policy EFDA Food Service Account Management Fasihuddin recommends adopting a Food Service Account Management Policy based on Norwell Public Schools. Said policy will include:
 - the number of meals students will be allowed to charge whether full pay and reduced meal benefit;
 - o prohibition of charging a la carte items when a student has a negative balance;
 - o explanation of a free meal benefit;
 - outstanding balance notification procedures;
 - o the collection process;
 - and debt forgiveness
- Policy JJF-R Replenishment of Student Activity Funds Fasihuddin recommends revising existing policy to reflect recommendations from auditor and to accurately reflect current practices.
- Adjournment Grant moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:55 am. Fasihuddin seconds. Vote 2-0-0.

Decisions/Actions/Discussion

- School Committee will review the drug, alcohol, and tobacco education program as recommended by the Superintendent at a regular meeting of the School Committee.
- Policy Subcommittee reviewed MASC Policy JLCD Administering Medicine to Students. Policy
 Subcommittee does not recommend adopting this policy at this time. The Hadley Health Office currently
 has policies and procedures in place governing medication administration and medication delegation in
 alignment with DPH regulations, state and federal laws, and as recommended/directed by the school
 physician.
- Policy Subcommittee discussed compensation rates for non-union employees who work hours outside of their normal work day (e.g., food service workers who work an athletic banquet). Policy Subcommittee recommends continuing with existing practice of paying overtime for all hours worked over forty (40) hours in a designated work week.
- Policy Subcommittee will review policies quarterly. Policy review will consist of:
 - o review of policies as recommended by MASC legislative and policy updates; and,
 - o review of one subsection of the Hadley Policy Manual each quarter.
