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ACADEMIC PRESENTATIONS TO THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE

- 1. The School Committee may request that academic presentations from the administrative team be presented at the regular committee meeting every other month during the academic year (September, November, January, March, May).
- Topics may be suggested by members of the administration or requested by the School Committee. Final selection of topics will be the responsibility of the School Committee chair in consultation with the superintendent.
- 3. The goal of academic presentations should be to educate the School Committee and the public on substantive issues in the Hadley Public Schools.
- 4. The superintendent should provide advance information and materials so the School Committee can ask appropriate questions.
- 5. Presenters should link their program directly to advancing student achievement, well being, and success and demonstrate value for the investment made by the school committee and town.
