a. Locker Painting at Hadley Elementary School and Hopkins Academy – A. McKenzie stated that painting lockers is a part of the long term capital improvement plan. This is a specialized painting project in that special paint and painters are required to paint lockers. This is considered a construction project under State law, so a State approved vendor must be used, or the project must go out to bid. A. McKenzie stated that even though the School Committee previously approved use of School Choice funds for operating expenses in the School Budget, she wants them to be aware of the estimated cost in the range of \$50,000.00. School Committee members were supportive of the project.
