

CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT

In lieu of a Diploma, the School Committee will award a Certificate of Achievement at graduation to any student who fails to meet the Massachusetts Competency Determination requirement prior to their anticipated graduation date, provided, however, that the student meets the following requirements:

- Completes a program of studies prescribed by the School Committee or the student's IEP team that satisfies all Hopkins Academy graduation requirements, including attendance requirements.
- Participates satisfactorily in the tutoring and other academic support services made available by or approved by Hopkins Academy under an individual student success plan, an IEP, or under any other plan designed to strengthen the student's knowledge and skills of the learning standards of the subject(s) at issue.
